


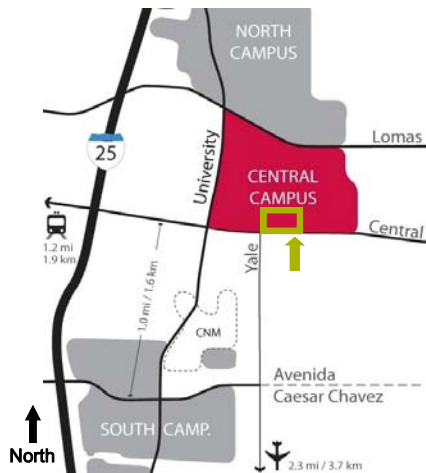


# UNM CAMPUS ARBORETUM: SELF-GUIDED TOUR #1

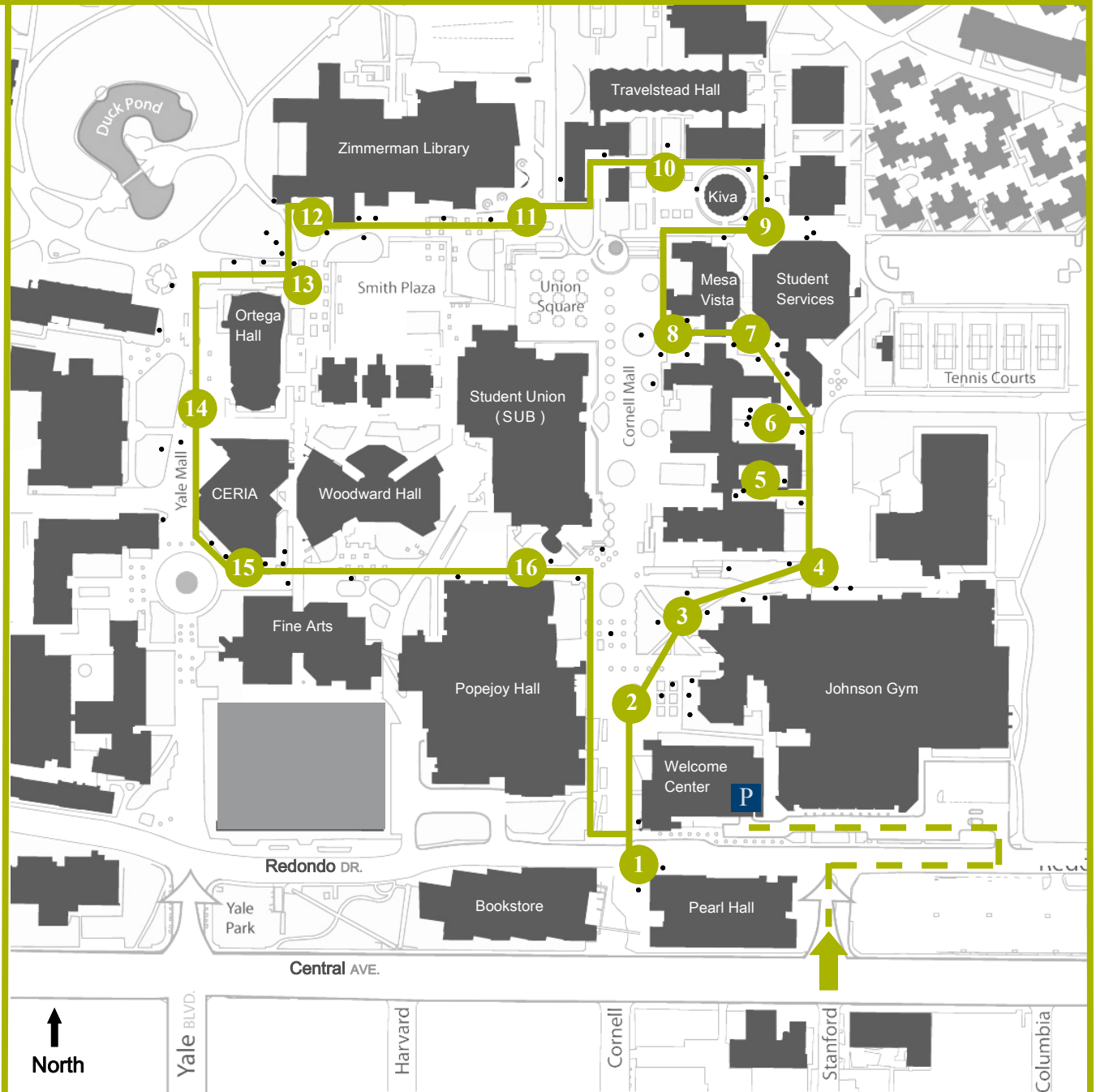
